

Radio Calls

In the Circuit:

Taxi Call

Cessnock Traffic, Cessna 172 [call sign] taxiing Runway [rw]. Cessnock

Entering and Line Up Call (before crossing the holding point)

Cessnock Traffic, [call sign] entering and lining up Runway [rw]. Cessnock

Rolling Call

Cessnock Traffic, [call sign] rolling Runway 35 for circuits. Cessnock

Base Call

Cessnock Traffic, [call sign] turning Base Runway [rw] Touch and Go. Cessnock

Clear of all Runways

Cessnock Traffic, [call sign] is clear of the runway. Cessnock

In the Training Area:

Departing to the Area

Cessnock Traffic, [<u>call sign</u>] is departing Crosswind Runway [<u>rw</u>], on climb pass through 1000 for 3000 for the training area. Cessnock

Inbound from the Area

Cessnock Traffic, [call sign] is 5 miles to the East at 3000, inbound on descent. Cessnock

Overhead the Airfield

Cessnock Traffic, [call sign] is overhead the field at 1800, descending on the dead side to join Crosswind Runway [rw]. Cessnock

Joining Crosswind

Cessnock Traffic, [call sign] is joining Crosswind Runway [rw]. Cessnock
